# Cota is seeking new members to join its SUFAC (see attached Terms of Reference).

At this time, we are specifically seeking:

• Two (2) new members who are active Service Users of a Cota service.

In order to ensure diversity of representation on the SUFAC at this time, preference will be given to individuals who are actively enrolled in Cota service for people living with acquired brain injury, developmental disability or dual diagnosis but all are welcome to apply.

• Three (3) new members who are Family Members of someone who is actively receiving a Cota service.

In order to ensure diversity of representation on the SUFAC at this time, preference will be given to family members who are relatives of persons actively in receipt of a Cota service for people developmental disability or dual diagnosis but all are welcome to apply.

### SUFAC Members Should Be:

- Able to attend regularly scheduled SUFAC meetings, either in-person or virtually (Meetings will be held September, November, January, March, May and June)
- Comfortable in sharing their thoughts and perspectives on a wide range of topics aimed at assisting Cota to promote true Service User and Family Centered care within the organization;
- Open to provide feedback and offer insight based on their personal experience with Cota and/or the broader health care/social service systems, as applicable;

- A chance to give back to your community

- An opportunity to engage in advocacy, research, public speaking / presentations
- A chance to meet new people and network with those who share a common interest
